The town has requested assistance from SC DOT for our drainage issues. Many of the town culverts, ditches and drain lines are completely or nearly completely stopped up, not allowing the water to flow from the streets. Please keep your yard debris picked up, so it does not enter the roadway hence entering the drainage system causing blockage. If your property has a ditched area that allows the water to flow to a drainage area, please do not barricade or block for any reason with tree limbs, construction debris, rocks, etc. The water must be allowed to flow from the streets and properties to enter the drainage system.

This is a good time to mention cleaning of your yards and sidewalks. Cooler weather allows for those who wish to walk through town and enjoy the scenery this option. Please be mindful of tripping hazards along the sidewalk. If you have a sidewalk in front of your property, please remove the grass and debris from the sidewalk. If you have a tree and it extends over the sidewalk, please cut it back. Should you have any questions, give us a call.
