Fire Chief Oliver Dowdle also wanted to share the results of the department's Insurance Services Office (ISO) evaluation. The department is excited that they remained at a rating of a "4" with a score of 64.01 out of a possible 105. This evaluation plays a vital role in the underwriting process for insurance companies to use when deciding what to charge for insurance coverage to homes and businesses. ISO comes in about every five years for a (PPC) Public Protection Classification Survey to evaluate each department in several different areas and review the records and documentation that are kept regarding the last three years. This includes training for each member, number of calls in the last three years, the required equipment the department has on each truck etc. Each department is evaluated in the following areas: Communications, Fire Department Capabilities, Personnel, Personnel Training, Water Capabilities, Education and Enforcement.
