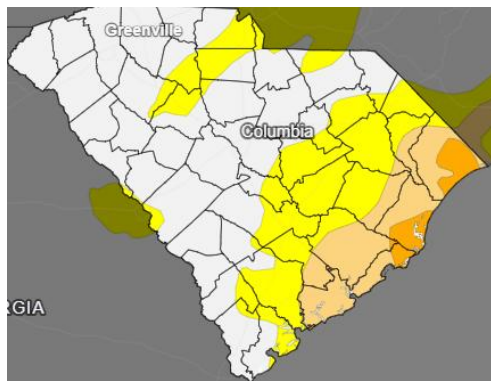
The Town would like to remind everyone that there is an ordinance in place prohibiting the filling of pools. Ordinance 9 says, **absolutely no filling of pools is allowed from the Town's water system**. We do not have enough water to provide for pool filling. We also ask that customers conserve their outside usage such as watering grass, washing cars and watering flower gardens.
